

1-4	1 st couple lead down and, raising right hands, woman turns to the right under the hands while man dances to the left to finish both facing up
5-6	1 st couple lead up to finish in the middle of the set facing each other with back to first corners
7-8	1 st couple set pulling right shoulders back to finish facing first corners 9-10 1 st couple and first corners, giving right hands, turn once round
11-12	1 st couple and second corners, giving left hands, turn once round to finish 1 st man between 2 nd couple facing down and 1 st woman between 3 rd couple facing down and 1 st woman between 3 rd couple
13-16	1 st couple set advancing to each other and, giving right hands, turn three quarters to finish in second position on own sides facing out
17-24	All dance reels of three on own sides (1 st woman right shoulder to 3 rd woman and 1 st man right shoulder to 2 nd man), on bars 23-24 1 st couple, giving left hands, turn three quarters to finish in second position on own sides
25-28	All, giving hands on sidelines, advance and retire 29-32 All, giving right hands to partners, turn once round

Repeat, having passed a couple.





- 17- 1c set | turn RH ³/₄; set | turn RH ³/₄, while{8} 2c+3c pass RH on the sides | set; cross RH | set
- 25- 1c set | pass RH ; cast R into 2pl, while{6} 2c+3c pass RH on the sides | set ; cross RH | all set. (2,1,3)



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Notes: In [17-32] traditionally the corners set R to the person just passed, then L to the next person to pass. In a variant for [19-24] 1c turns BH $\frac{3}{4}$ in PdB.

- **17–** All C Petronella Turn to partners and set ; repeat to finish in P's place
- 25- All M chase 1/3 clw while{4} all W 2/3 LHA ; join RH with P and set in star, all C turn RH ½
- **33–** All W chase 1/3 clw **while**{4} all M 2/3





- 9- 1c followed by 3c dance up between 2c, cast off ; dance NHJ down through 3pl, cast up to face 1cnrs, 3c looping into 3pl
- 17- 1c turn 1cnrs RH, pass Rsh (cnrs dance for {4}) ; turn 2cnrs RH (same), and cross Rsh to (2,1,3)
- 25– All circle6 and back
